Well as hard as it is going to be for Ron to re-live his ugly past, he's willing to do it for the sake of helping others and give them hope. The Lord has put across Pastor Ron's path a ghostwriter and publishing company that are willing to get the book completed, however they have told him it will cost around \$10k-\$15k to write and publish the book. Pastor Ron can't accomplish this without your prayers and financial support, so please pray for Pastor Ron and give generously to help him complete this difficult task.

In June 2011, when disastrous flood- waters chased residents of Minot, North Dakota, from their homes, the people of that community did what seemed to come naturally to them—they helped others who were in need. Ministry Prayer Needs

- 📖 Prayer is needed for our new opportunity in the Maui Community Correctional Center. The Chaplain has asked Pastor Ron to come and give 3 services a week to the inmates.
 - We need prayer for volunteers on Maui, Oahu & possibly Arizona to help Pastor Ron.
 - Financial support is greatly needed to cover airfare, lodging, transportation and food, during these trips to Maui, Oahu & Arizona.

 - Finances to Expand the Ministry (Matt. 9:37 & Luke 4:18-19). Weekend Conferences
 - Support for Pastor Ron's Book of his life to be written & Published (Expected cost to be well over \$15k)
 - Personal Financial Support for Pastor Ron Zaucha.
- 📖 Prayer for God's Hedge of Protection (Job 1:10) & Wisdom (James 1:5) for the Volunteers, Supporters & Board Members.
- 📖 Pray that all Hearts will be opened by the Power of the Holy Spirit to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior and make Him their Lord! That the Holy Spirit will transform them by the renewing of their minds (Rom. 12:2).
